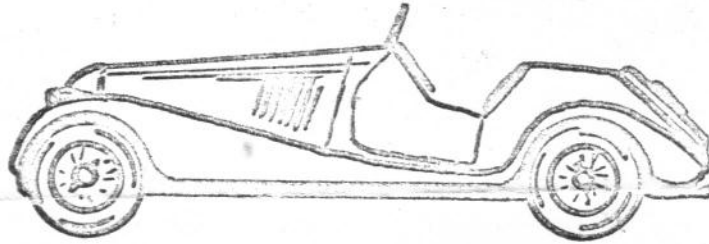

in October. A prototype was shown to the Morgan Three

to be equal to a Lamborghini. The factory has accepted an  
order from Ken Miles of Toronto and from Ken's investigations  
we understand that the Rover V-8 will be tuned to provide  
165 H.P. (apparently a very conservative rating) with  
practically unlimited development potential. The front end  
has been beefed up and a new transmission is being considered.  
The Drophead Coupe and Four Seater will probably be switched  
to the 4/4 chassis.

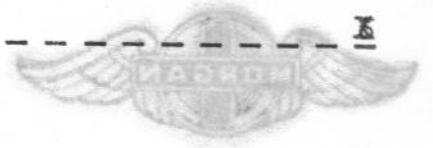
