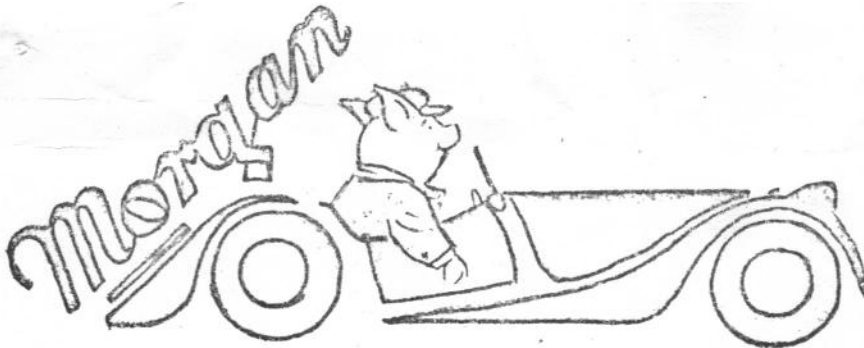

PIPER'S HILL FARM

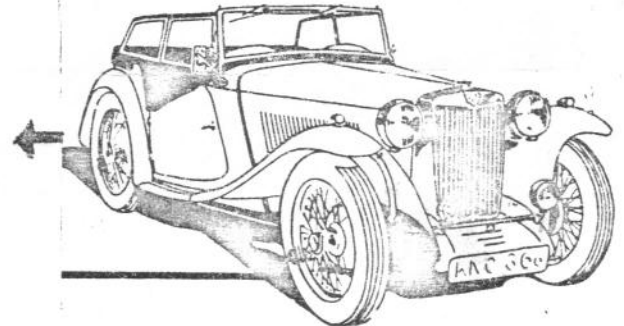

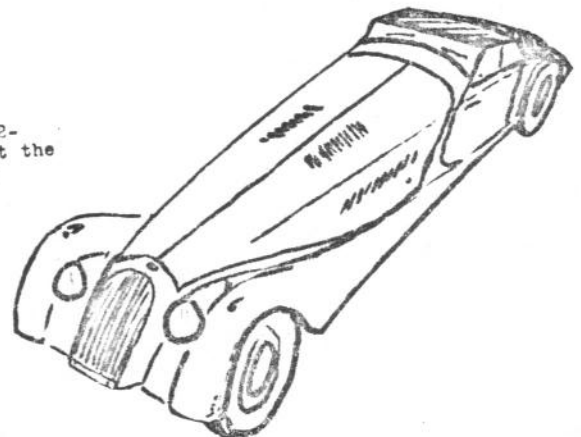

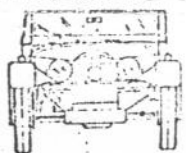
### MODEL MAYFAIR

**RUNNING ON...**

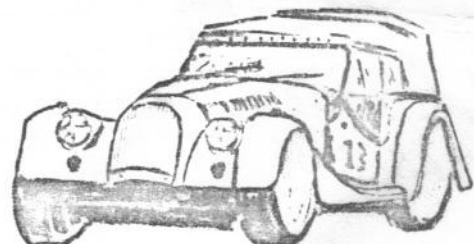

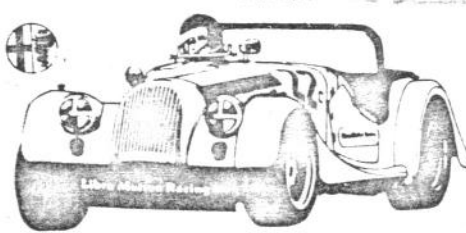
